- Shoreline off limits to all vehicles
- Park closes at sunset
- Helmets required for bikes, ATVs, & open vehicles with no roll bars

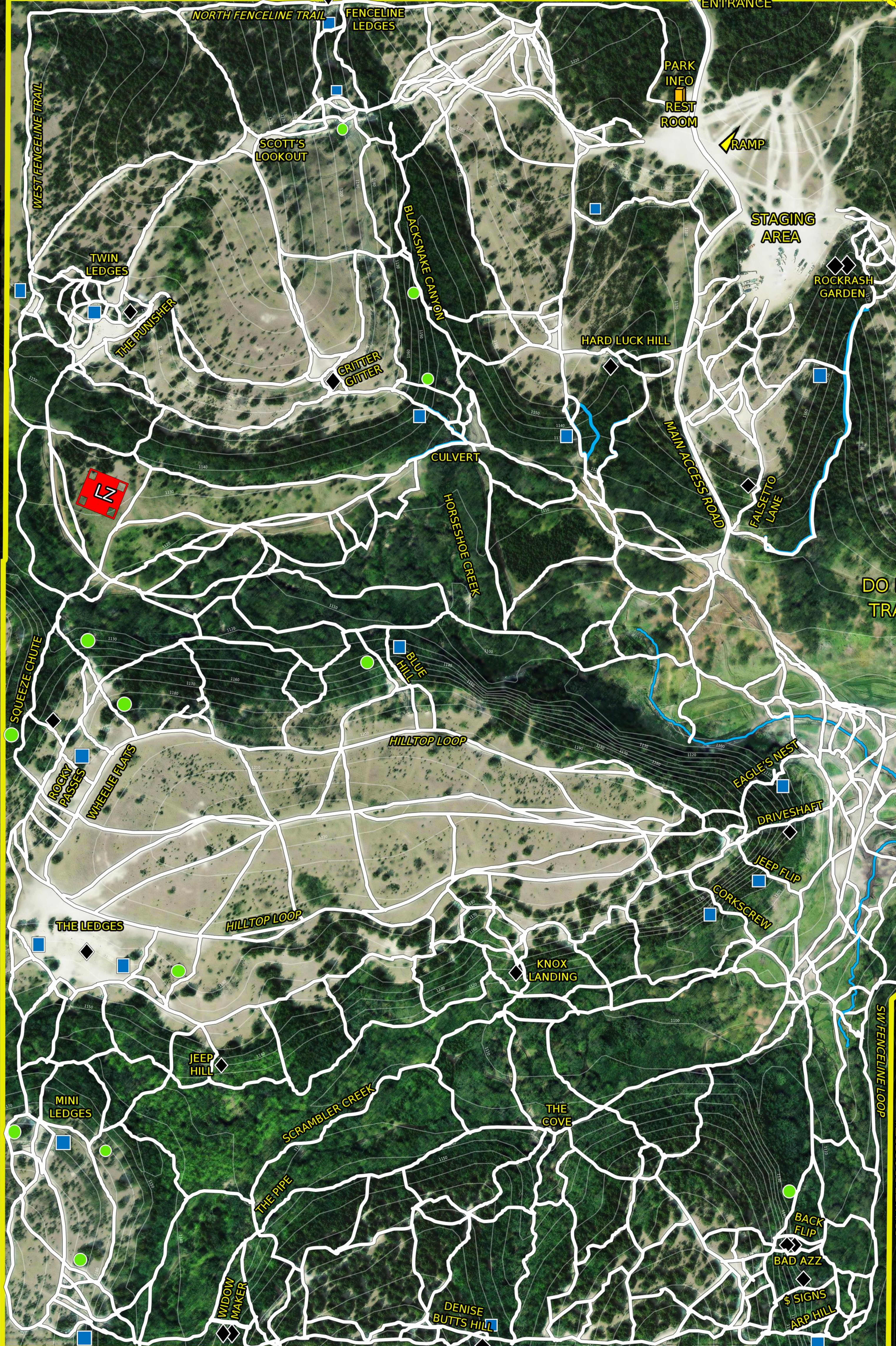
OFF LIMITS DURING WET CONDITIONS

- Easy (stock 4WD capable)
 - Moderate (lift, larger all terrain tires & winch are recommended)
 - ◇ Hard (lift, larger AT tires & winch needed; lockers are recommended)
 - ◇◇ Advanced (enhanced off road vehicles only; winch & lockers required)
- Never wheel alone! Have a plan-remember to adjust ratings upward for wet/snowy days
